

Recruiting firm Quantum Solutions expands

Recruitment and consulting firm Quantum Solutions for Business has moved into expanded offices at Donley Plaza in North Austin.

The Houston-based company, which is branding itself under the abbreviated name Q4B, specializes in recruitment outsourcing services worldwide and says its Austin recruitment operations center has taken 12,000 square feet of space in the building at 2201 Donley Drive near the intersection of Burnet Road and Braker Lane. The new office is part of Quantum's plan to triple its recruiting team this year and broaden its capacity.

The company's recruitment center was formerly housed in 3,500 square feet at 2222 Western Trails. The new center is more than triple the size of the previous space.

Nick Tubach, president and founder of Quantum, says the company's growth is being driven by customer demand for talent outside of North America.

"I am very pleased with the increasing mid-market trend to outsource non-core business functions," Tubach says, adding that that trend has necessitated the move of the Austin center for the second time in as many years.

In addition to its Houston headquarters, Quantum has a recruiting extension in Chicago. But the Austin recruiting center is considered the hub of the company's national operations.

The new center features an open arena in the center of the office allows recruiters and researchers to share experience and knowledge and provides synergy among recruiting teams. Other features include large conference rooms, training rooms for new recruiter boot-camp, a large break room, visitor lobby, directors' offices and an open reception area.

"Clients will benefit from a larger team of dedicated recruiters operating with their own tools and a team leader, all working under professional project management," says Scott Beardsley, co-founder and vice president of recruitment services. "Our recruiters are trained in a variety of proven techniques and tools and operate in a controlled environment where they can track the process."

The new Austin office is the first prototype operations center in Quantum's plan to expand and build multiple recruiting centers across North America.
